

What we are learning this term ATTENBOROUGH CLASS SPRING 2023



English



This term we will be exploring a wide range of exciting texts including 'The Day I Swapped My Dad For Two Goldfish', 'Leon and the place between', 'The Adventures of the Dish and the Spoon'. Children will be writing persuasive texts, poems and narratives.

Maths
