

What we are learning this term CURIE CLASS AUTUMN 2023

English



This term we will be exploring a wide range of exciting books including Stanley's Stick by John Hegley, How to look after your dinosaur by Jason Cockcroft and the Jolly Christmas Postman by Janet & Allan Ahlberg. Children will be writing lists, stories, and diaries.

Maths



We will be mastering numbers to ten: counting, comparing, ordering, regrouping, finding patterns and making numbers. We'll then look at numbers to twenty. Children will also explore Geometry including positional language and properties of shapes.

Science



Our Different Animals topic will introduce children to lots of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, exploring what they eat and observing other similarities and differences.

RE



We will be exploring Christianity through our two big unit questions: 'What do Christians believe God is like?' and 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?'.
