

What we are learning this term LUTHER-KING CLASS AUTUMN 2023



English



This term we will be exploring a wide range of exciting books including Coming to England by Floella Benjamin, Cinnamon by Neil Gaiman and Monsterology by Dugald Steer. Children will be writing poetry, stories, diaries and reports.

Maths



We will be mastering place value with up to three decimal places as well as exploring the properties of numbers including multiples and factors. We'll explore the formal written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and short division.

Science



Our Earth and Space topic will explore the movements of the Earth, Moon and other bodies within our solar system. Children will also use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

RE



We will be exploring Christianity through our two big unit questions: 'What does it mean if God is loving and Holy?' and 'Was Jesus the Messiah?'.
