#### English

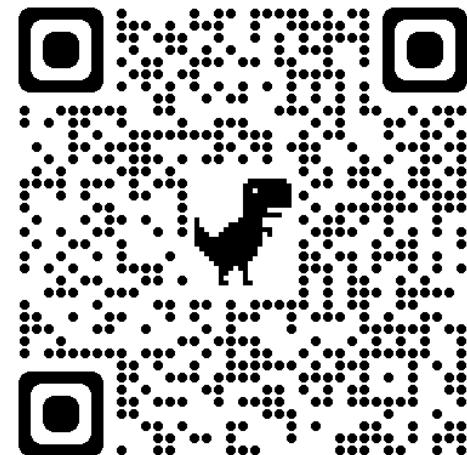
