Sports Premium Funding - 2015 - 2016

What is Sports Premium?

Sports Premium is additional funding given to publicly funded schools in England to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer. In the 2015-2016 financial year, schools will receive the following funding:

• Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £8,000 and an additional payment of £5 per pupil.

Purpose of Funding

Sports Premium Funding should:

- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that your school already offers
- make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years

Therefore, it is suggested that schools could use funding to:

- hire qualified sports coaches to work with teachers
- provide existing staff with training or resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively
- introduce new sports or activities and encourage more pupils to take up sport
- support and involve the least active children by running or extending school sports clubs, holiday clubs and Change4Life clubs
- · run sport competitions
- increase pupils' participation in the School Games
- run sports activities with other schools

Areas identified for development

- increase staff confidence in teaching PE, specifically gymnastics and dance
- develop the quality of all staff teaching when delivering PE
- provide a wide range of sporting opportunities for all pupils within PE lessons and as extra-curricular clubs
- get involved in district competitions and tournaments
- increased range of equipment for specific sports

Partnership This gives us access to specialist secondary PE teachers who provide in school modelling and training for Key Stage 1 and 2 staff and who run specific sporting sessions in preparation for tournaments and competitions. Transport is also provided for the children to and from competitions and tournaments throughout the district.	Develop staff skills and confidence throughout the school to provide high-quality PE lessons. Provide opportunities for more children to get involved in a wider range of sports and to compete against other schools.	£2500
Level 6 PE Qualification The PE Co-ordinator will complete a PE qualification to raise the profile of PE within the school and provide a sustainable training system for all teachers delivering PE. Change4Life Club Two members of staff are running a Change4Life club for selected children to provide opportunities to develop co- ordination and control as well as increase their level of physical activity.
